Further to my recent Medical Report (31/05/11), this is just to confirm that Bob came back for a follow-up and was seen on the 20 June.

He confirmed that his stimulating device is still working in a very satisfactory manner.

His visual analogue pain scores were such that preoperatively, he was experiencing pain of around 8-9/10 on a 0-10 scale of severity and following stimulation, these scores have dropped to around 2-3. He is less fatigued, sleeps better and has entirely better mobility than previously.

I trust this answers the various queries that you had at the time.
